Opportunity for MPhil and PhD Studies in Hong Kong

Greetings from the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST)! I am writing to ask for your help in advising students, particularly those interested in research studies, that HKUST is a great choice that they shouldn't miss out on. In the spirit of greater academic and cultural diversity, our international students come from over 60 countries. We are keen to welcome and nurture talents from all over the world to join our postgraduate community.

Students may wish to know that Hong Kong has consistently been rated as one of the best student cities (QS #11). QS also ranked Hong Kong in the Top 25 for student mix. HKUST is a research-focused university with an international outlook and innovative spirit. Though relatively young, we are a globally recognized university (QS World Ranking, #30), rising fast through ground-breaking research and stellar international faculty. We aim to provide our students with a holistic education, inspire them to flourish academically and drive to change lives for the better.

At HKUST, students will find a wide selection of programs in science, engineering, business and management, humanities and social science, environmental studies, and public policy – all taught in English. HKUST offers a studentship of HK\$16,330 (about USD\$2,100) per month to our research postgraduate students and guaranteed university housing will be available for the first two years of study. Moreover, we encourage students to pursue their PhD through the Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS), an internationally recognized award established by the Hong Kong government. HKPFS Fellows account for one in six of HKUST's PhD students, a testament to the quality of our students. In addition, we provide a scheme to sponsor selected international students at undergraduate or master's level to experience a taste of working in a cutting-edge research environment for a few months.
